

# LiU hereby advertises a Research Preparatory Scholarship in Cancer Pharmacology

## Research environment

You will take part in research activities at the within the Division of Pharmacology and Clinical Chemistry at Linköping University. The group focuses on molecular mechanisms underlying cancer therapy response and resistance, combining advanced cell biology, molecular signaling, and translational approaches.

## Research project

The project investigates mechanisms of sensitivity and resistance in Multiple Myeloma, a plasma cell malignancy with high relapse rates. The work aims to explore cellular pathways involved in treatment response and identify molecular markers that could guide future therapeutic strategies.

## Qualifications and requirements

A research preparatory scholarship may only be awarded to individuals who have been admitted to studies on advanced level at LiU. The studies should provide practical experience in research work in order to strengthen the connection between education and research, as well as to encourage future doctoral studies. A study plan needs to be developed and handed in together with the application.

The recipient of the scholarship should be eligible to begin doctoral studies or be expected to meet the eligibility requirements through other studies during the scholarship period, excluding the studies funded by the scholarship. A scholarship for research preparatory purposes may not be awarded to individuals who have already been admitted to doctoral studies.

## Starting date

January 19, 2026

## Appointment and Conditions

A scholarship for research preparatory education may cover a maximum of 40 weeks per recipient. However, each scholarship decision may only apply to a period of up to 20 weeks.

The scholarship amount is equal to the study grant and loan from CSN, for 2026 3 398 SEK per week.

Note that a Scholar may not receive any additional remuneration (including allowances and other fringe benefits) from Linköping University during the period of the scholarship.

## **Application procedure**

The following documents (in pdf-format) must be submitted when applying for a scholarship

1. Curriculum vitae with relevant copies of reviews
2. Short individual study plan provided by the supervisor (including bibliography)
3. Admission notification to a research preparatory course at Linköping University or another university with which LiU has collaboration, which alone or essentially aims to prepare for graduate studies.
4. Copy of current passport
